16 Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. 17 When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. 18 And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

17 Be faithful even in times of great doubt – depends on Christ

18 Christ is our authority, in Salvation & Instruction (Savior & Lord)

19 Make disciples – learners and followers – All people

19 Baptizing them in the Name of Trinity

20 Teaching them to obey ALL that Christ has commanded

19 Go (poreuō) = to pursue the journey on which one has entered

20 Christ will be with us ALWAYS until time ceases

Why – because we will need His strength

3:1-2 Sardis = dead Church & Imperfect works
