Have faith even in the face of doubt

Go make disciples

Teach them to obey ALL that Christ taught

Christ will be with us always

Slide 2

Mt. 28:19 Go (poreuō) = to pursue the journey on which one has entered)

Mt. 9:35 Jesus WENT about the cities and villages

Slide 3

35 Teaching = Didaskō = to instruct, instill doctrine

Preaching = kēryssō = to proclaim, with a gravity and an authority which must be listened to and obeyed

36 He had compassion

for they were harassed = weak, enfeebled, exhausted.

36 and helpless = rhiptō = cast down

36 Like sheep without a shepherd

37 Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. 38 Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."
